

Addendum to the Bylaws of the Friends of the Fletcher Free Library - April 2021

This addendum is written to address a needed change to Section Three of Article V: Officers, Board of Directors, Elections and Other Duties.

Section Three: Election

A portion of Section Three currently states:

Officers shall be elected for a one year term by a majority vote at the annual meeting. The President, if reelected, may serve a total of three consecutive terms. There are no term limits on the tenure of the other officers.

Given the unforeseen impact of the recent global pandemic, the board would like to declare this an emergency and remove the term limit applied to the office of President.

The following is a revision of that portion of Section Three: Election

Officers shall be elected for a one year term by a majority vote at the annual meeting. There are no term limits on the tenure of the officers.

This addendum will be voted on and approved by the Board of Directors of the Friends of the Fletcher Free Library. It will be reviewed annually, at least six weeks before the annual meeting, to determine if it remains relevant. The Board will then either reauthorize the addendum or remove it from the Bylaws by a majority vote of the Directors.
